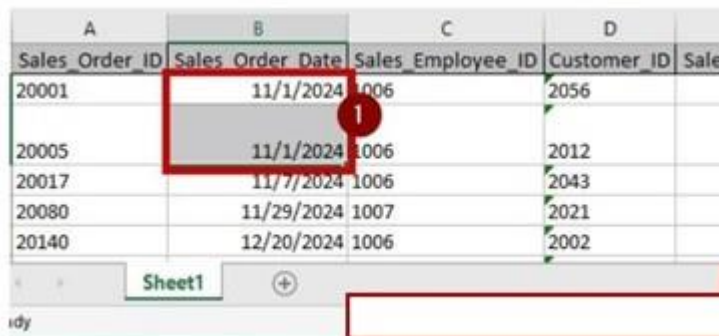

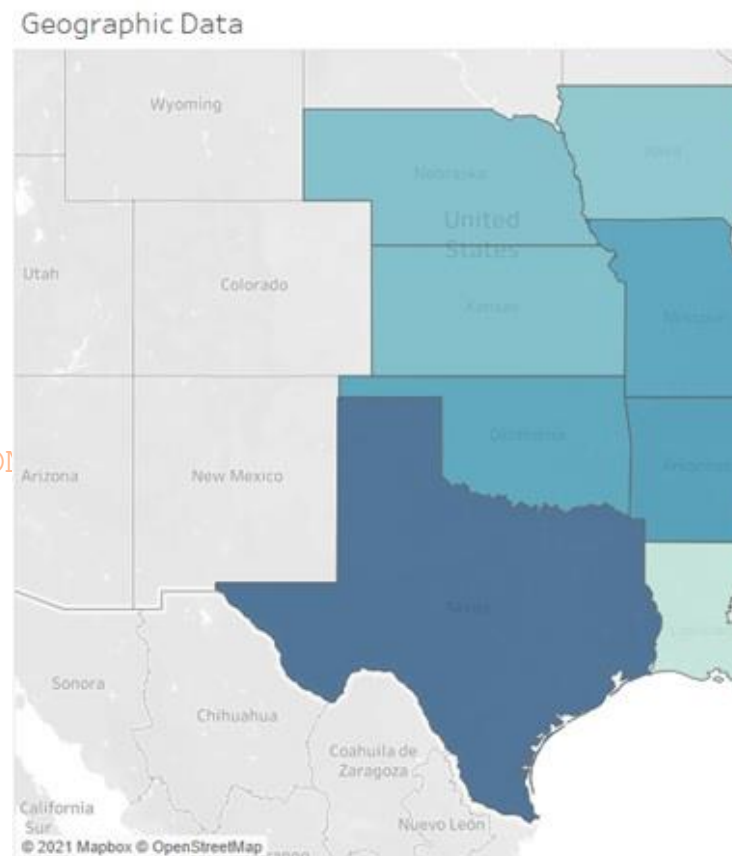

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To get the average customer rating, the system would have to compute the average of all customer ratings to date, making it a calculated variable.

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Since the companies have gathered, collected, and processed their own internal data, they know the quality level of that data and can better decide if it is useful in answering management's questions.

71) Essay

Enterprise systems, or ERP systems, are a type of business management software that integrates applications and data from throughout the business (such as manufacturing, accounting, finance, and human resources) into one system. Since the enterprise system is stored in common databases in one location, they are called centralized databases.

72) Essay

Knowing whether the data conveys facts or opinions, or has errors or missing data is an important consideration when determining if the data can address business questions.
